Dear Fritz:

First let me tell you how much I appreciate you letting me meet with you last Thursday evening. I had such a wonderful time talking to you. As promised I am emailing the details of my supposed purchase of the Pacher property through Leslie Maximilien. And I'd love to DHL you a copy of the Oprah interview as well as my interview with Diane Sawyer and Mr., Rivera. So please email me a good address for DHL. I so look forward to nmeeting with you again in the begining oif June when I shall return.

My husband and I contributed \$40,000.00 to the Foundation. The \$40,000.00 was paid to Leslie Maximilien with the promise by Mr. Maximilien that the Foundation would get at least eight to ten acres (or approximately 2 to 2[] carreaux) of the Pacher land. In addition, Mr. Maximilien stated that he would donate another 10 acres to make our total ownership of 18 to 20 acres for the amount of \$40,000.00. Mr. Maximilien claimed that he owned property immediately adjacent to the subject property.

The Foundation transferred the funds to Mr. Maximilien in two tranches - \$20,000.00 on or about December 30, 1999 and a second payment of \$20,000.00 several months later in the spring of 2000. Title to the property was to be transferred to the Foundation.

In March of 2001, on a recent trip to Haiti with my husband, we found out that whatever title the Foundation was supposed to get was in Leslie Maximilien's personal name. Mr. Maximilien ("Maximilien") had an explanation for the reason for the title being lodged in his name, and a detailed of explanation of why the land was involved in a lawsuit in the Haitian courts.

Maximilien said that he had transferred some sort of interest to the Foundation by virtue of a letter where he acknowledged that he was acting as nominee. A copy of the letter will be enclosed in the materials I will send you, together with some of the other background information.

Maximilien argued that in the Pacher area the Meves family will go to court without papers to challenge anyone's right or claim of ownership. He explained that the Meves family used to raise sugar cane in the area and that the family owns a vast area in the Pacher district. Maximilien claimed that the Meves family always asserts ownership against anyone attempting to possess the land or build because the Meves family will neither physically remove them from the property, prevent the surveyor from getting on the land to conduct a survey, or go to court without papers.

Maximilien claimed that the Meves family had gone to court claiming ownership of the subject property. He said that he then needed to hire a lawyer and that they have gone to court three times in front of a judge. Maximilien claims that he received a judgment and that the court then ordered an investigation of the judgment. Maximilien said that he then had to go to the Pacher district with three police officers to conduct the investigation. He claimed that the investigation had been completed and the results of the investigation had been filed with the Court.

Maximilien then claimed to have had a meeting with the person who handles matters in the Pacher district for your family. Maximilien claims he was proposing to give this individual two carreaux of land in order to resolve the dispute and get clear title to the remainder of the land. Maximilien says that he has thirteen carreaux in addition to the subject property, and that he would take some of that land to pay the individual who was interfering with the ability to complete the court case and obtain clear title.

At this time, the Foundation is out its \$40,000.00 and we apparently have no title to the subject property. I will enclose copies of the limited documents that we do have with respect to this property. I am grateful for any time or attention you can give in helping us reclaim the \$40,000.00 Maximilien took from the Mercy & Sharing Foundation. Our intention was to build an orphanage and it has been a great financial loss.

I would really love to have dinner with you during my next trip to Haiti, May 31 through June 7, 2001. So please put me on your calendar.
